I do hope you are well and Happy New year.

Thank you for your emails and information in relation to the Stoke Lodge playing fields and the alleged criminal damage that has occurred over the last few months and weeks. I will allocate an officer to further investigate these incidents thoroughly and deal with any suspects who come to light positively. I am hopeful that the witnesses will be able to identify potential offenders and the officer in the case will also look at any CCTV that is available.

In relation to the allegations against Cotham school relating to the fence the Police have reached the following decision.

We feel that it is not in the public interest to pursue a Police investigation at this time as we do feel that conducting a lengthy criminal prosecution would not be proportionate in the circumstances and there is a high potential for further litigation at the High court in relation to the ongoing civil proceedings relating to the fence which we hope will help resolve the matter.

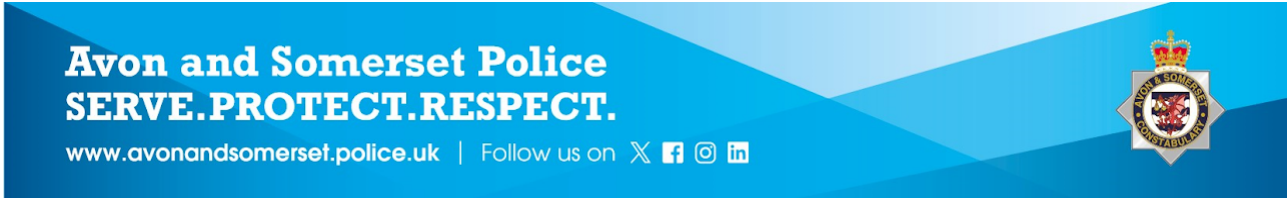
